- 11:00hrs - move to the NAL (at the eastern end of the same building) for a 1hour talk by the librarian, Brian Riddle, and some time for you to browse the library.
- 12:30hrs - Outside for a short walk around the historic buildings remaining from the RAE days with David Wilson who has a portfolio of photographs which give some idea of what is inside and what the buildings were used for.
- 12:50hrs - Return to Aviators for lunch. A table will be booked
- 13:45 hrs (approx) - Move to the FAST museum for a short talk from David Wilson on the very early history of flying at Farnborough and on Samuel Franklin Cody; visit the replica of the first aeroplane to fly in the UK and the rest of the museum. Tea/coffee will be provided at around 15:15 / 15:30 with departure at 16:00.

Parking is available outside the Aviators Cafe (Marked "Visitors to the Hub") or, in O'Gorman Ave, outside the NAL at the eastern end of the building and opposite "Rainbows" nursery.
